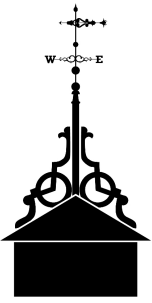

In preparation for the 2010 Oktoberfest event to be held in Hopedale on October 2, 2010, the Friends of Historic Hopedale has released the application for street vendors, art/crafts vendors, and yard sale/flea market vendors.

The venues for this year's event include Hopedale Street, in front of the Little Red Shop Museum, the Hopedale Parklands, the Hopedale Pond and, new this year, the Town Park. The event will feature entertainment, tethered hot air balloon rides, model airplanes landing on Hopedale Pond, the National Guard, American Red Cross Emergency Center Vehicle, Lion's Club Sight Mobile, many food vendors and much, much more.

Last year's event attracted over 3,000 people and this year's event promises to attract many more. The application can be printed from the various area news web sites, the Little Red Shop Museum Facebook page and on the website littleredshopmuseum.org.

Date: Saturday, October 2, 2010 (Rain date: Saturday, October 9)

Time: 10 AM – 4 PM; food vendors & beer tent close at 7 PM ~ Set-Up to begin at 8 AM

Location: Museum grounds, 12 Hopedale St., Hopedale, MA, & surrounding area

Registration Fee: Street Vendor booth space - \$50 (includes a complimentary LRSM apron or t-shirt)
Art/Craft Vendor space - \$30 (includes a complimentary LRSM apron or t-shirt)
Yard Sale Vendor space - \$20

The non-refundable registration fee must accompany this application and must be received by August 15, 2010. Late registration fees are: Street Vendor space - \$65, Art/Craft Vendor space - \$40 and Yard Sale Vendor space - \$25. Approval will be subject to availability.

Space: All street spaces are 12' x 12'. Lawn spaces are 10' x 10'. If a larger space is required, a double space may be reserved (prior to Aug. 15) at a fee of \$80 for Street Vendors, \$45 for Art/Craft Vendors and \$30 for Yard Sale Vendors. All vendors must provide their own set-up; please note that electricity will **not** be available. The Friends of Historic Hopedale will review and approve applications and assign spaces for approved applicants based on vendor type.
